GE Aviation, CFM end air show with billions in orders

Jet engine makers **GE Aviation** and **CFM International** left the Farnborough Air Show in the United Kingdom with more than \$9 billion in orders.

CFM, a joint venture between GE Aviation's parent **General Electric Co.** (NYSE: GE) and **Snecma** in France, booked 540 new engine orders, and a materials and services agreement. The deals were worth more than \$5 billion at list price.

GE Aviation's tally included a \$2 billion deal with **Southwest Airlines** for GE's OnPoint Solutions unit to maintain and overhaul all of Southwest's CFM56-7B engines over a 10-year period.

GE Aviation and CFM International are headquartered in Evendale.
