**HEBRON** — European aircraft maker Airbus has order six of MAG Cincinnati's largest fiber placement machines to build the composite fuselage panels for the upcoming A350 extra wide body jetliner.

MAG Cincinnati, part of MAG Industrial Automation, said the six VIPER Fiber Placement Systems would be installed in Airbus plants in France, Germany and Spain and are capable of producing fuselage panels more than 20 feet in diameter.

Airbus and its European vendors have purchased 14 MAG Cincinnati composite systems over the years to produce components for the Airbus A320, A330, A340, A380 and A400M aircraft.

The extra wide body A350 slated for service in the middle of the next decade will be capable of carrying between 270 and 350 passengers over long-range routes.
