TechSolve showcases advanced manufacturing expertise at 2010 Defense Manufacturing Conference

Manufacturers from across the country will be gathering at the Defense Manufacturing Conference (DMC) in Las Vegas, Nevada, November 29 through December 1, 2010. The conference is the annual flagship defense manufacturing technology forum for exchanging ideas, assessing technical project progress and discussing the challenges of the defense industrial base. Conference organizers invited representatives from TechSolve to present on current advanced manufacturing initiatives.
