

Honda To Make Investment Announcement In Anna

Ohio Gov. John Kasich will be in western Ohio on Wednesday for an investment announcement at American Honda Motor Co.'s Anna manufacturing plant, the Dayton Daily News reports.

Honda hasn't released details of the announcement, saying only that it is a "major investment," the newspaper reports. The automaker builds engines for its vehicle at the 2,400-employee plant, which produced more than 770,000 engines in 2010, the newspaper reports.

The company also plans to detail plans for an additional assembly line at its Russells Point transmission plant in Logan County, the newspaper reports.
