

L-3 Fuzing wins \$35.9M contract

L-3 Fuzing and Ordnance Systems in Union Township was awarded a \$35.9 million military contract to supply electronic bomb fuzes to the Navy and U.S. Foreign Military Sales program, the Pentagon announced. Friday.

The work, including 20,000 electronic bomb fuzes, 200 dummy fuzes, 100 cutaway fuzes and 3,000 accessory kits, was split between Union Township and Orlando, Fla., and should be completed by September 2014.

The majority of the work for the Navy was to be completed this fiscal year, according to the contract announcement.
