## Cold Jet opens new plant

Cold Jet, a leader in dry ice blasting and cleaning systems, opened a 14,600-square-foot machining and manufacturing plant in Milford on Thursday.

The company, based in Loveland and founded in 1986, builds nozzles, dry ice blasters and dry ice production equipment.

The new plant represents a \$2.5 million investment, Cold Jet said in a press release. It has clients in the automotive, plastics and rubber, packaging, medical device, printing, food processing and contract cleaning industries.

Cold Jet uses non-abrasive recycled CO<sub>2</sub> in the form of dry ice pellets or particles for a variety of cleaning procedures to reduce waste and eliminate the need for toxic cleaning approaches.

Cold Jet, a privately held company, also has international operations in Europe, Asia, Middle East, Canada and Mexico.
