Additional Requirements/Qualifications:

Education/Experience:

US Citizenship required due to sensitive nature of job with defense contracts. BS in Engineering required (Manufacturing Concentration Preferred) – MS in Engineering preferred (Manufacturing Concentration Preferred). Proficiency in software applications required for the performance of job duties. Industrial experience is a plus.

Language Skills:

Must be able to communicate both orally and in written context effectively at all organizational levels. This includes making presentations, serving as an instructor or facilitator, and preparing reports for a variety of internal and external audiences.

Reasoning Skills:

Individual must be a team player with the ability to exercise independent, sound judgment and discretion; be able to plan; be well organized; work well under pressure; take initiative, be flexible and cooperative with the ability to multi-task.

Physical Demands:
