

ELEVEN OHIO PROJECTS TO CREATE AND RETAIN 6,851 JOBS

Projects Invigorate Regional Economies, Leverage Investment in Ohio

General Electric Company (Hamilton County) will receive a \$1 million Rapid Outreach Grant for the costs associated with the acquisition of new machinery and equipment in support of the company's project in the Village of Evendale. General Electric produces large and small jet engines used for commercial and military aircrafts, supplies aircraft-derived engines for marine applications, and provides aviation services. The Village of Evendale is home to the company's 400-acre, 6 million-square-foot worldwide headquarters, and the company has additional locations in the surrounding area. This project is expected to retain 5,000 jobs.

The Thaler Machine Company (Warren County) will receive a \$40,000 Rapid Outreach Grant for the costs associated with the acquisition of new machinery and equipment in support of the company's project in City of Springboro. Thaler Machine Company, established in 1952, is a privately owned manufacturer of precision machine components for the aerospace and automotive industries. The company designs and develops components for multiple applications, including prototypes and full-scale production. This project is expected to create 35 jobs and retain 76 positions.
